Chrysalis

As the Chrysalis representative for the Limestone Ohio Valley Emmaus, I wanted to let you know more about the opportunity that starts with a Chrysalis weekend for young people, ages 15 to early 20s (entering 10th grade and up). "Chrysalis" is the name chosen for the youth and young adult version of The Walk to Emmaus, its parent movement, because it symbolizes the spiritual growth that is essential between adolescence and adulthood. That growth is as crucial for youth as the cocoon is for the caterpillar. We have 2 Chrysalis communities that serve young people from the Limestone Ohio Valley Emmaus - one is Greater Cincinnati Chrysalis, whose weekend Flights (Walks) and RUSH (Gatherings) take place

The Greater Cincinnati Flight weekend for the young women is June 26-28 and young men's is July 24-26. The Flights for the Southern Ohio Chrysalis are both scheduled for July; however the dates have not yet been posted on their website.

Several members of our community have worked with youth on Chrysalis and additional ones have been part of the Chrysalis weekend as a participant. This would be an excellent way to help a young person, near to your heart, experience the Love of Christ that you experienced on your Emmaus Walk!

AGAPE!

Many of us will want to share tangible expressions of God's Love for the men's and women's walks; each of us fondly remember the expressions of His Love we received on our Emmaus Walk. Get with your share group or some of your Emmaus Brothers and Sisters and begin creating Agape gifts for the Pilgrims to receive during their Walk. During the Walk we share God's love by participating in the 72-hour Prayer Vigil, attending Sponsor's hour, praying, attending Candlelight and Closing.

A couple reminders - please create 30 pieces for bedtime Agape (if it is for Pilgrims only) and 60 pieces for mealtime Agape (write on the outside of the bag/box how many pieces you brought). It is fine to put names of Share Groups and churches on Agape pieces, but please do not put individual names on the Agape pieces. As the Limestone Ohio Valley Emmaus community, let's help show the love of Christ to the pilgrims on these walks!
